From San Francisco/Oakland:

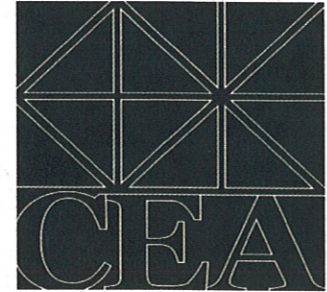
